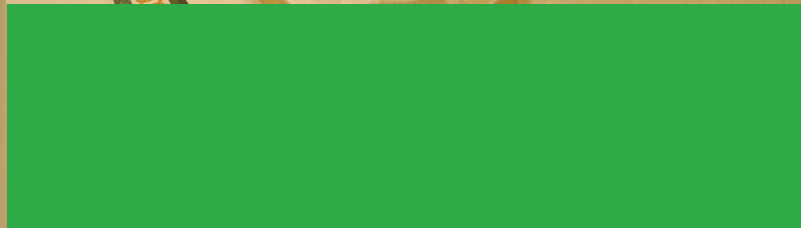

Scope of work

Construction of the embassy complex with the ambassador's residence and consular building, boundary wall, entrance gate and guardroom, car parking, hard and soft landscaping and utility connections on a plot of 5,400 square metres. The embassy and consulate building consist of three storeys and a total floor area of approximately 2,500 square metres. The ambassador's residence comprises two storeys and a total floor area of approximately 2,000 square metres.
